Course Description: Topics to be covered include the solution of linear systems by Gaussian elimination; linear spaces, subspaces, and bases; inner products and orthogonality; the Gram-Schmidt procedure; linear transformations and matrices; determinants; eigenvalues and eigenvectors; the singular value decomposition; quadratic forms; matrix factorizations.

Homework: Problem sets will be assigned each Friday and due the next Friday at the end of class. Late homework will not be accepted. Students are encouraged to work together on problem sets; however, each student must write up the solutions in his/her own words.

Quizzes: Quiz will be given occasionally in class. No notes and calculators are allowed during the quiz.
